

New Devon Double Top—the elevating roof with everything.

Easy, swing-up action

The Devon Double Top's fibreglass roof runs the full length of the vehicle. Yet you can easily raise it with the help of its two gas-filled struts.

When the Double Top is down, locking catches secure it firmly for travelling.

More headroom, more bedroom

With the Double Top raised, you've lots of extra headroom and space in your Devon Motor Caravan. If you remove the bed sections you can enjoy this extra height throughout.

But where the Devon Double Top really scores is with increased bedroom.

Double bed upstairs . . .

There are two solid-base bed sections in the roof – one at the front and one at the back. These can be slid together to give you a double bed 6' 1" long by 3' 9" wide.

Each 36½" x 45" bed unit has a strong internal frame with rigid polystyrene forming an insulated 'sandwich'. A high-density foam mattress (covered in toning material, colour keyed to the interior upholstery) is attached to the top of each bed section.

Or twin beds for children

Slide the two bed sections back to opposite ends of the Double Top, and you have two excellent single beds for children.





Luxury finish – inside and out


The tough, good looking vinyl roof skirt tones with your Devon's exterior colours.

The entire Double Top interior and the undersides of the bed units are lined with attractive carpet-style material.

For fresh air, two ventilators are fitted at each end of the roof.
